Dear Parents & Players,

Thank you for your interest in Warsaw Travel Soccer Club this spring season. Attached is a commitment form for your player to read and sign. Our purpose is not to intimidate or discourage but to make clear our goals for these older teams. For those of you who have been committed and consistent in your participation to Wave, we apologize for the strong language in the form. We had trouble last season with kids not showing up for practices, making their commitment to soccer second to other interests and it hurt coaches and other teammates. Due to the six man rule we are trying to make clear to all players what we expect from them in order to build the best teams possible. The non-refundable money, should your son/daughter make a team, is also due to picking teams in the past and then having them collapse at the last minute because kids found another interest. We will not have as many teams in the spring so if your child makes a team, he is probably bumping someone else out.

This commitment form is not unique to our club. We have consulted other programs and the requirement for money and the signing of the form has been the most effective way to create a committed team. This in turn ensures the best possible experience for all players. Thank you for your support of the Warsaw Wave and please feel free to contact us with any questions you may have.

WARSAW TRAVEL SOCCER CLUB PLAYER COMMITMENT

Players and parents please carefully read and sign the following:

1 I understand that if I am chosen to participate on a WARSAW TRAVEL SOCCER CLUB team, I am committing to being part of that team. As such, I will take my responsibility to my team seriously. **I understand that I am expected to attend all team practices, games and tournaments** - This includes games and tournaments on weekends, including Sundays, and occasionally Sunday morning.

2 I understand that the commitment I am making is for the Spring **2005** season-- from March through the end of June. I will limit my other activities to avoid conflicts with the commitment I am making to my Warsaw Travel Soccer Team. I understand this includes other high school sports.

Please list all high school spring sports in which you participate: _____

Warsaw Travel Soccer Club does not intend to hinder your participation in high school activities. We are only asking that you commit to your Wave team so that your absence does not hinder your team. Except for very unusual circumstances, it is next to impossible to give the 100% required for you to succeed at 2 or more sports at the same time. If you believe your circumstances will make it possible to participate in both, please explain on the reverse side of this form how you intend to handle scheduling conflicts.

3 I understand that there may be occasions when due to injury or extenuating circumstances, I will not be able to participate. Although those situations will be rare, I agree to be honest with my coach and notify him/her as far in advance as possible.

4 I understand that my conduct at practices, games and tournaments is a reflection of me as an individual as well as my team and my Club. I will follow the instructions of my coach concerning conduct.

5 I will, at all times, demonstrate good sportsmanship and good citizenship. I will conduct myself in a manner that brings credit to my team and to me.

6 **I am submitting the required \$100 commitment fee.** I understand this fee is necessary to secure my commitment and my position on a team. This commitment fee will be credited to my account if I am chosen to play on a Warsaw Travel Club Team. The balance of the fees will be paid (not yet determined) by mid-February 2004 for the Spring Season.

If I am chosen and placed on a team, the \$100 commitment fee is NON-REFUNDABLE.*

If I am not chosen for a team, the \$100 commitment fee will be returned promptly.
