Registration Fees Policy

As of September 24, 2008

The purpose of this policy is to define the process of paying dues in a timely manner. In addition, this policy will define the consequences if dues are not paid.

1) At tryouts, a deposit of \$100 is required. If the deposit is not received, the player may not tryout, unless previous arrangements have been made with the coach or Board of Directors. If the player is not chosen for the team or if the family decides not to play, the deposit will be refunded in full.

2) Remaining fees can be paid in three ways:

a) In full at pre-season due date (preferred method)

b) Apply for scholarship funds by the scholarship due date.

3) If fees are not paid by the end of the season, the player can not play the following season. If all back fees are paid for the previous season and a deposit is made for the next season, the player maybe considered for participation.

4) If fees are not current, a player may be denied a transfer to another Club (per IYSA rules and guidelines). WTSC has the responsibility to report this to IYSA.

5) Coaches and managers have the responsibility to work with the Board on communication and collection of the registration fees to the player and their families.

6) Fundraiser (Kroger gift card) money maybe used either for the down payment of \$100 or the remaining fees. It is the responsibility of the Board to communicate to each family and team the amount in their Kroger fundraiser prior to registration.
